AND


2. Sri Guru Gobind Singh College, Sec 26, Chandigarh, Represented by the Principal of the college

4. That (Sri Guru Gobind Singh College, Sec 26, Chandigarh) would extend infrastructural facility for conduct of seminar conferences workshop etc.


5. That faculty development programme (FDP) of two week duration would be conducted by RCED with the objective:

- To provide information to the participants about various sources for getting training and research assignments for the college


6. That both the parties may nominate members to various seminars and conferences on Entrepreneurship and Skill development being organized by respective parties
