The College maintains an Institution Level Feedback Report. Feedback on curriculum and infrastructure is collected on a specific format from students and alumni .The results are formulated by statistically quantifying the received feedback forms.

Data collected is consolidated and a report is prepared. Data entered in the feedback forms are then analysed and suggestions/feedback given by the stakeholders is given due attention.


1. Student Feedback


Faculty feedback is regularly collected from students to evaluate and improve the teaching learning process. The analysis pointed out that most of the students are satisfied with course organization, syllabus coverage, content coverage and availability of study material. Students also are satisfied with the evaluation process followed by faculty and practice through assignments. Few students feel that there is need for improvement in teaching methodologies such as concept building, skill development and practice through assignments.







(ii) Teacher


Gathering and valuing student feedback on faculty leads to engaged students, responsive faculty and collective efficacy. More than eighty-eight percent students are satisfied by the teaching methodologies used by faculty; however few of them feel that more innovative methods should be used by faculty while teaching. The feedback analysis further revealed that almost all the faculty have thorough knowledge of their respective subjects and have a friendly and helpful attitude towards their students. Moreover the faculty are easily accessible to the students. Most of the students think that the evaluation done by most of the faculty is fair and unbiased.




The feedback is analysed and the conclusions are passed on to decision making authorities through Principal for incorporation in improvement processes at the College level.


(i) Institution Infrastructure



The analysis of feedback collected pointed out that majority of the students think that the laboratories are well equipped and are also satisfied with the hostel and canteen, but some of the students want improvement in basic amenities, like drinking water and sanitation. They also feel that the medical room (Bhai Kanhaiya Health Centre) and Girls Common Room need to be upgraded.







(ii) Administration




















c) Foreign Student

Feedback is collected from foreign students to assess their overall experience as students of this College and to invite suggestions from them, in order to provide them with conducive and helpful environment. The analysis of collected feedback pointed out that most of the foreign students were happy and satisfied with the level of support they got at the time of admission. Majority of them found the study environment, cultural experience, and overall experience satisfying. Although sixteen percent of them found the level of support and cultural experience as poor and ten percent of them were unhappy about the overall experience.


2. Alumni Feedback



Around five percent of the alumni think that Training and Placement Cell needs to work more actively to provide placement opportunities to students. 
