

- 1.3 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MOU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MOU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. 





Memoirs from the pen of the first Editor of Agammi Jyot

Sri Guru Gobind Singh College, Chandigarh, admitted its first batch of the students in July 1966. Some teachers were also appointed and I was one among

them. After having taught for ten years at Jullunder and Sangrur, I joined the college on 30.11.1996. Some of my colleagues have gone but I am still around though I was born as early on 6.11.1936. The institution, having seen some ups and down is celebrating its Golden Jubilee when it is experiencing quite some qualitative and quantitative up-swing.

Sikh Educational Society, a proud product of India's freedom movement launched the project of the College to commemorate the tri-centenary of the birth of Sri Guru Gobind Singh, the perfect poet-thinker, saint-soldier in the long history of humankind on planet earth. Many stalwarts of the Society have gone including Sardar Bakhshish Singh, a close relative of Master Tara Singh who ensured the construction of a small building in 1966. The Society and the College, including the College Magazine 'Agammi Jyot', however, continue to remind us of the 'Perfect Man' in whose name the college was established.

Chandigarh had a small population and the launching of a new college was not without its risks given the small literacy base of the country. This College was the only co-educational college in the city in 1966. Nearly half of the faculty had some teaching experience and had migrated to the 'City Beautiful', the name given by Late. Dr. M.S. Randhawa a few months after the college started functioning. The staff and the management had to work really hard to attract students in adequate numbers to make it a financially viable institution. Many colleges in that period collapsed and had to be taken over by the government, SGPC and other organizations. Luckily quite a few really talented boys and girls joined the college in the very first year of its existence. May be, its co-educational character had something to do with this phenomenon in our fast changing society especially in urban areas.

University rules were not stringent and the Management managed to rope in a grand old educationist to be the first Principal in the personality of Dr Trilochan Singh. He, a saintly scholar, had long teaching and administrative experience.

He had also served as Director Public Instruction (DPI) in both the states of Punjab and PEPSU. He had the unique knack of inspiring young people to work hard and realize their full potential. The great man assigned two special tasks to me for which I had no prior experience.

One was to design college insignia with a quotation from Guru Gobind Singh's poetry. The whole operation was beyond me and I could only provide the necessary inputs for a highly respected painter Sardar Sobha Singh. Providing the quote was very rewarding as I did some reading before I suggested ਮਾਨਸ ਕੀ ਜਾਤ ਸਬੇ ਏਕੇ ਪਹਿਚਾਨਬੇ which was already on the lips of most Sikhs whom I knew. The great artist sent two samples. And note the generosity of the graceful Principal who insisted my choosing the one for the insignia, currently called Logo in the highly commercialized world.

The second was to take up the chief editorship for the college magazine and give it a suitable name. I consulted my colleagues and it was my senior college Prof J S Jogi (who later became Principal for about a decade) who suggested 'Agammi Jyot' as the name, which we all liked. I edited the magazine for two years till more competent editors were available with the increase in the strength of the faculty.

Chandigarh had a big printing press owned by the Government for its own needs but no commercial press to print the magazine locally. The job had to be done by a printer from Ambala. The second issue was published from the Co-operative Press, located in Sector 22.

There are memories galore of half a century of the glorious college but it is high time I stop. The college will go on forever.



Knowledge for the sake of knowledge is good, but knowledge without implementation is futile. We have to study the purpose of life and Guru Gobind Singh has given us a bold and new concept of living. This concept is embodied in his message of noble deeds - ਸੂਭ ਕਰਮਨ

The Pen and the Sword should go side by side. We must be supreme in the use of our pen, without it the sword will rust. There is the need of the Sovereignty of the Soul-- the realization of the Supreme within--which is the panacea of all the modern warfare and unrest.


