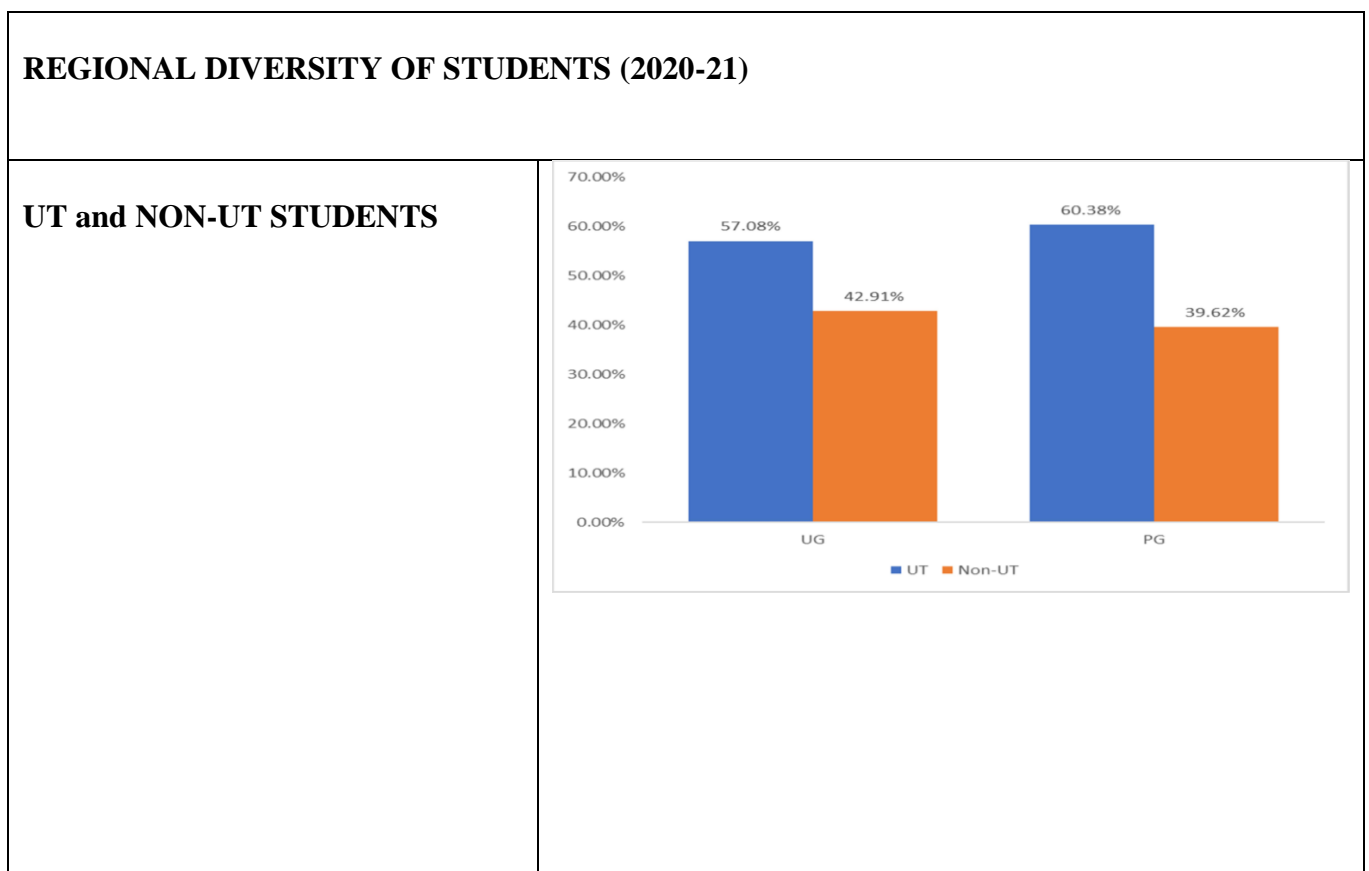

Number of Foreign Students –22 (2020-21)





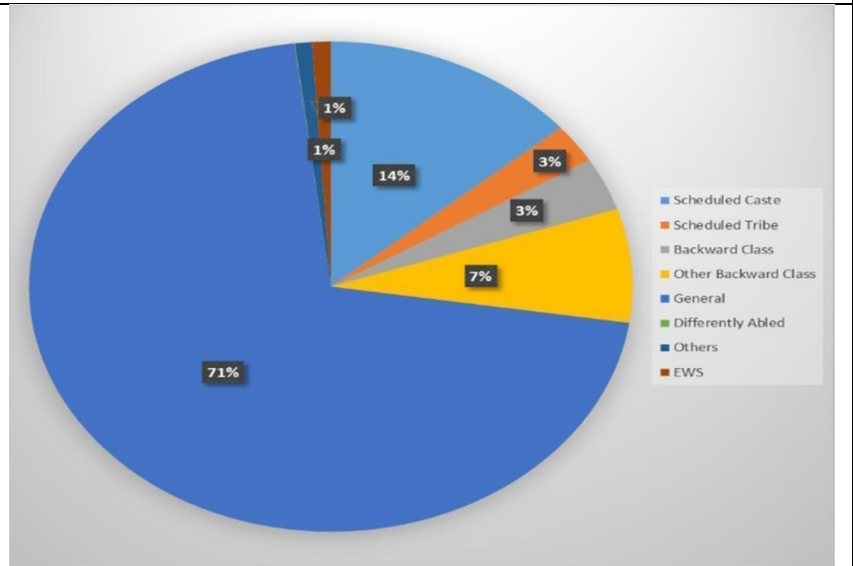

GENDER DIVERSITY (2020-21)

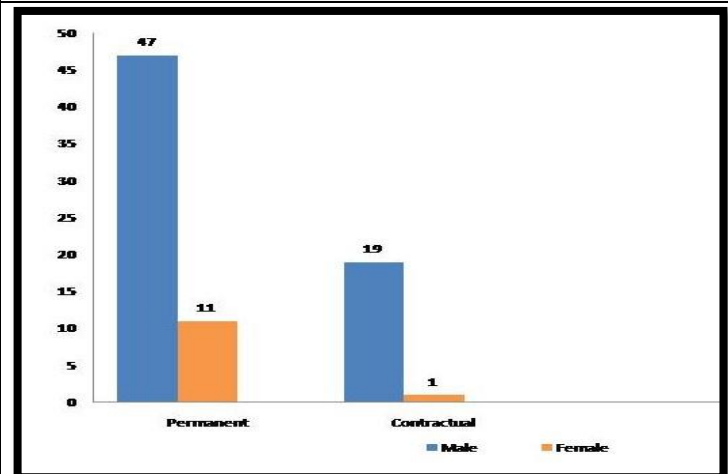

3. Linguistic Inclusion

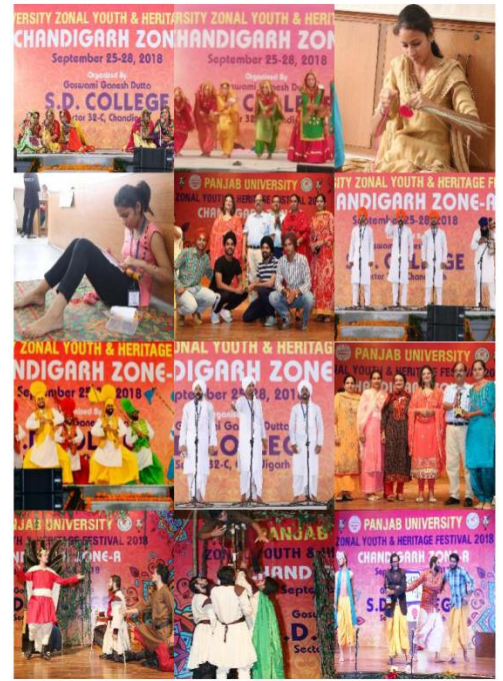
