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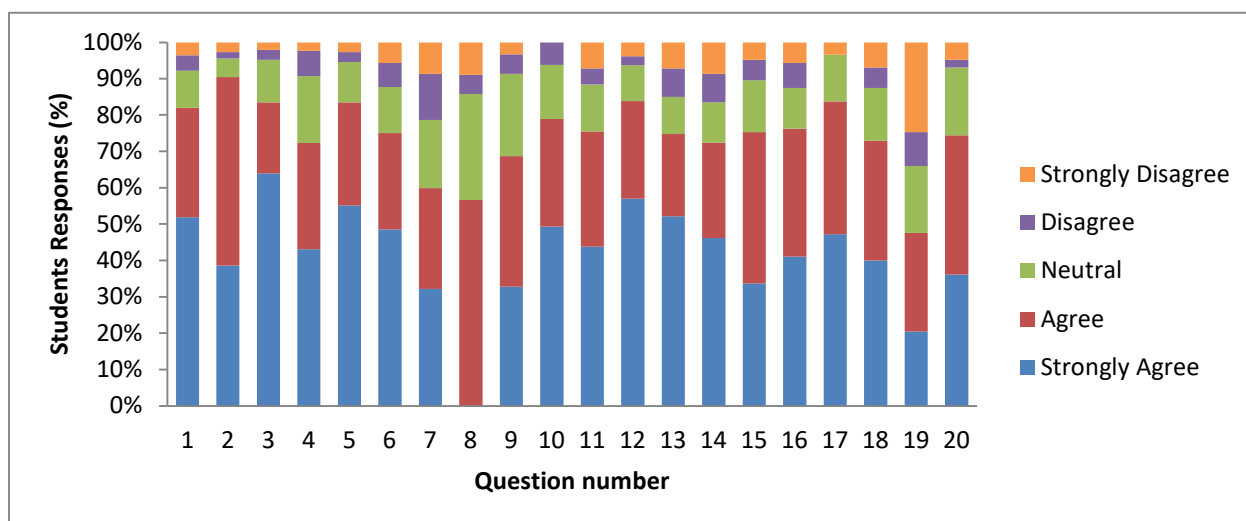

To assess the students' satisfaction on overall institutional performance for the academic year 2023-24 a questionnaire on various aspects like curriculum, teaching-learning processes, and internal evaluation was made. Students' Satisfaction Survey based on various aspects is rated on 5-point scale, from 0 to 4 i.e. 4 for strongly agree, 3 for agree, 2 for neutral, 1 for disagree, and 0 for strongly disagree. Around 81.9 % of the students were satisfied with the syllabus covered and the teacher's ability to impart knowledge effectively. Students also found teachers fair in the internal evaluation process.
