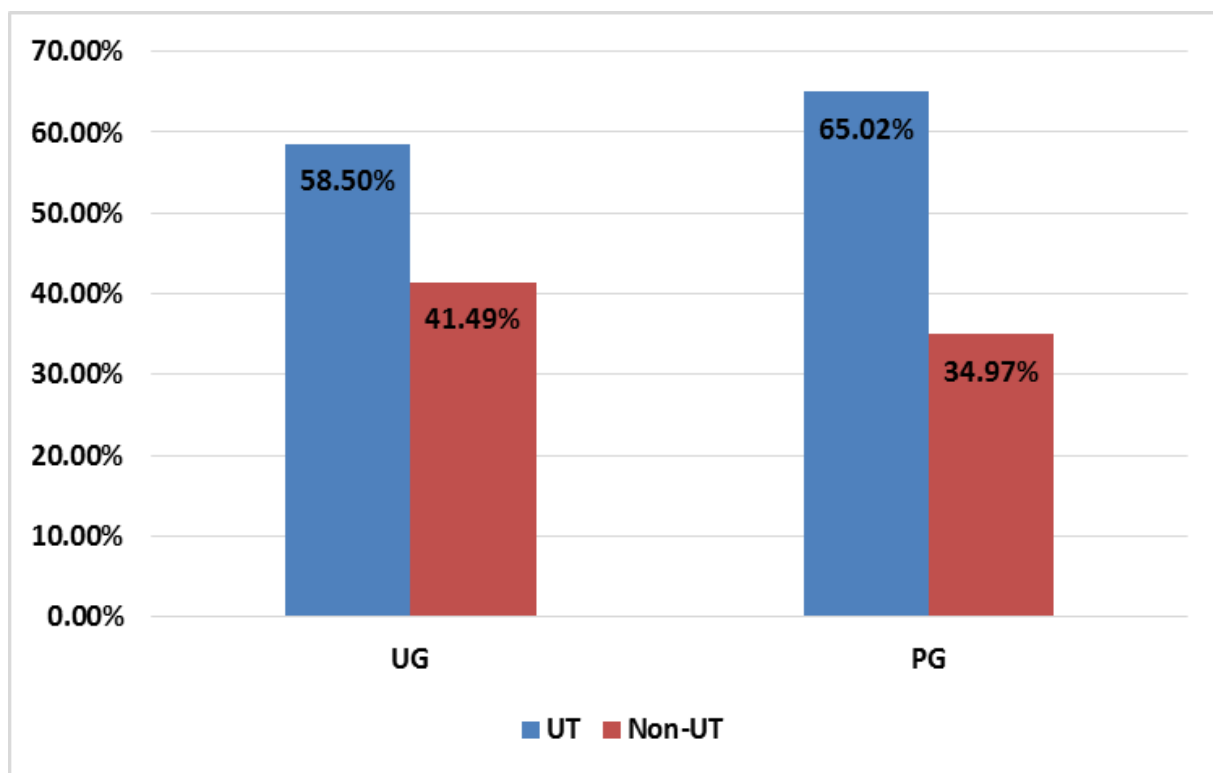


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## A. Regional Diversity ( UT and Non-UT )

## B. Number of Foreign Students

In the academic year 2021–2022, the College enrolled 51 students from Ghana and Afghanistan in various UG and PG courses. Out of them, 07 students studied on a self-financed basis, while 44 students were sponsored by the ICCR. Due to the pandemic, the students who registered for the current semester under the support of ICCR attended classes virtually from their home countries. The Dean of Foreign Students is looks after the welfare of International students. The students are made to feel at home. By fusing the wonderful experiences of other cultures with fresh viewpoints, regular cultural activities are undertaken for making teaching and learning a two-way process.



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## Holistic Development

### *National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF)*

National Skills Qualifications Framework (NSQF) has been set up in the College to promote lifelong learning and skill development of the students. The NSQF, a scheme under the UGC, aims to equip the students with key skills that will help better their career prospects. A Soft Skill Course - Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication (25 seats) introduced on a self-financed basis under the NSQF is being run successfully. Apart from teaching the curriculum of the course, regular training, interaction with different media personalities and visits to media lets such as Rozana Spokesman (under Green Media)-a Punjabi News Channel and newspaper - Naya Lokyuga, a Hindi Daily and NZ Punjabi News are organised for the students.

### *NET Classes*

The National Eligibility Test (NET) includes two different national-level exams i.e NTA-UGC NET and CSIR-UGC NET. The College provides coaching and guidance for preparation of NET exam for all the twelve PG courses, either by hiring some professionals or by the faculty of the College.

### *Remedial Classes*

The College holds Remedial Classes to address learning gaps and to improve the performance of slow learners. The classes are designed keeping in mind the needs of the target group. This enables one-to-one interaction making it possible for the teachers to monitor the learning and growth of the students.

### *ICT Cell*

The National Program on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) – A Project of IIT Madras, supported by the MHRD, Government of India, offers an opportunity to undergo free online certification courses in Engineering, Humanities and Science streams. The College has been recognized as one of the Local Chapters of NPTEL-SWAYAM on-line courses.

### *Student Council*

A democratically elected Student Council is constituted every year to inculcate a spirit of civil accountability and participation among the students. The Student Council works under the supervision of the Dean Student Welfare (DSW) to assist in the College affairs and activities. It actively organises various social, cultural, literary, sports and community-oriented activities. The Student Council comprises the President, Vice President, General Secretary and Joint Secretary.

### *Foreign Students Welfare*

Dean Foreign Students looks after the welfare of International Students. The students are made to feel at home. Regular cultural activities are conducted to make the teaching-learning truly a two-way process by amalgamating wonderful experiences of different cultures and new perspectives. The College enrolled 51 students from Afghanistan and Ghana in various UG and PG courses during 2021-22. Out of these, 44 students were sponsored by the ICCR and 07 students were studying on a self-financed basis.

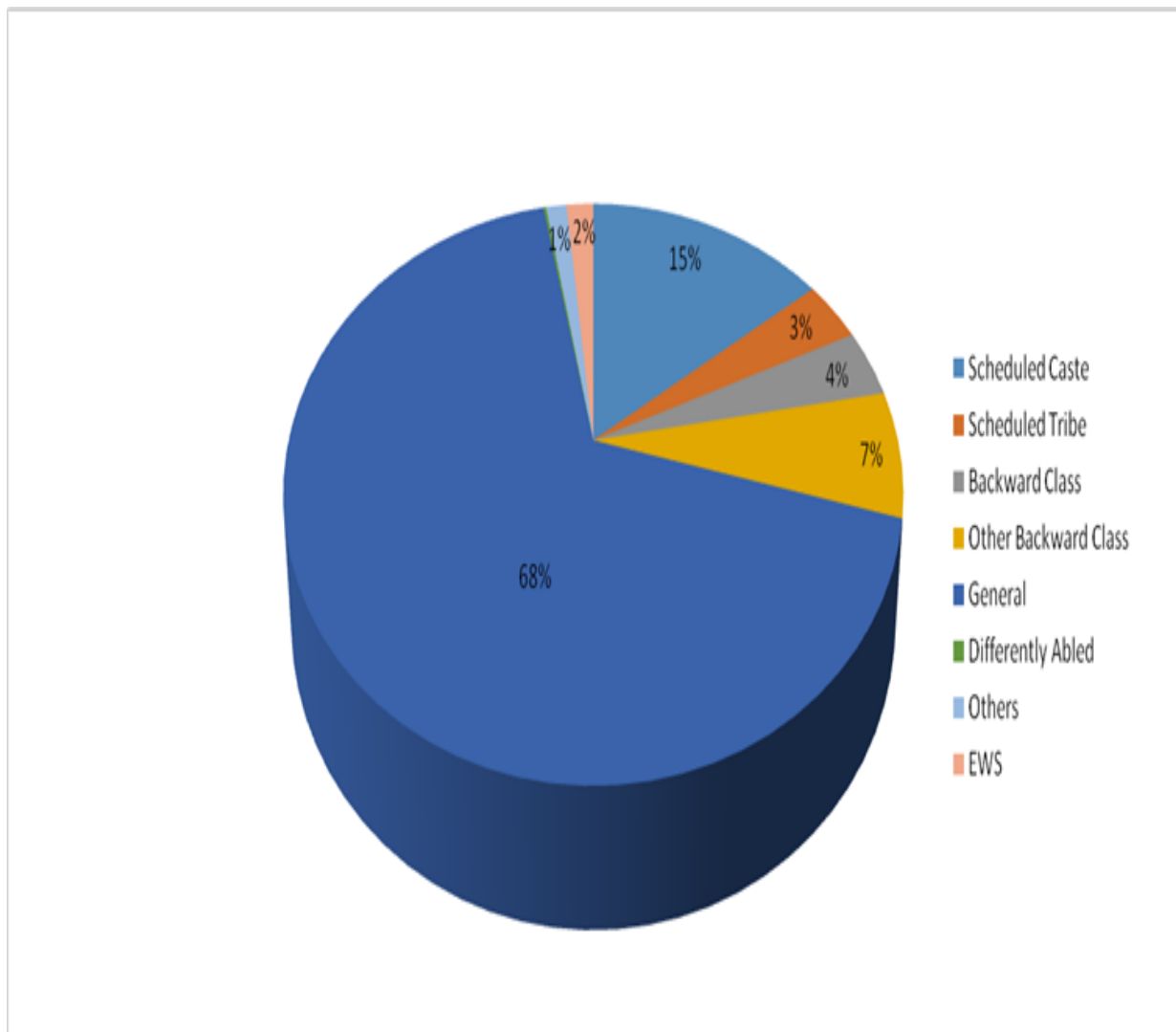
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## C. Social Diversity of UG and PG Students

**Pie-Chart of Social Diversity of UG Students**

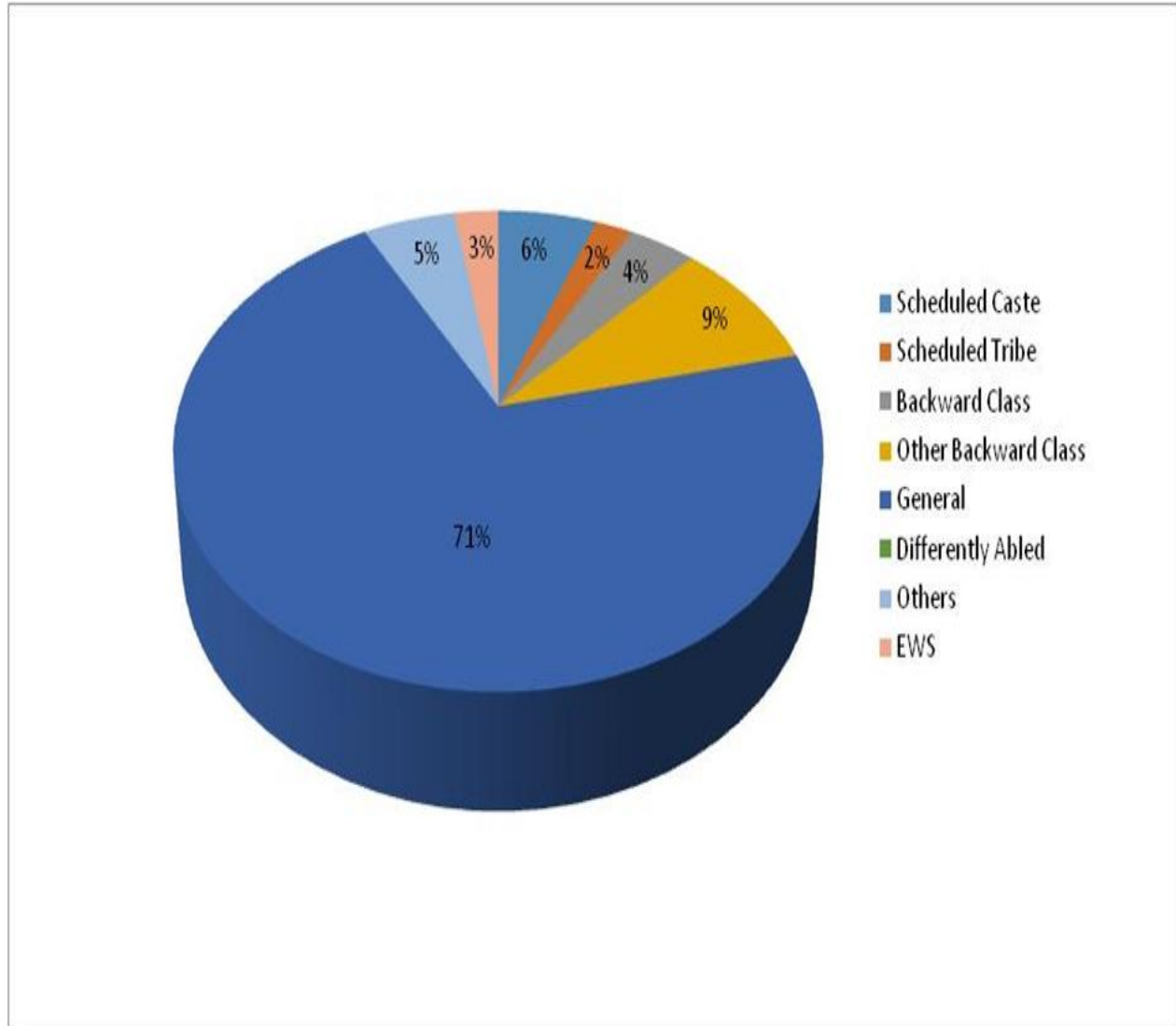




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**Pie-Chart of Social Diversity of PG Students**

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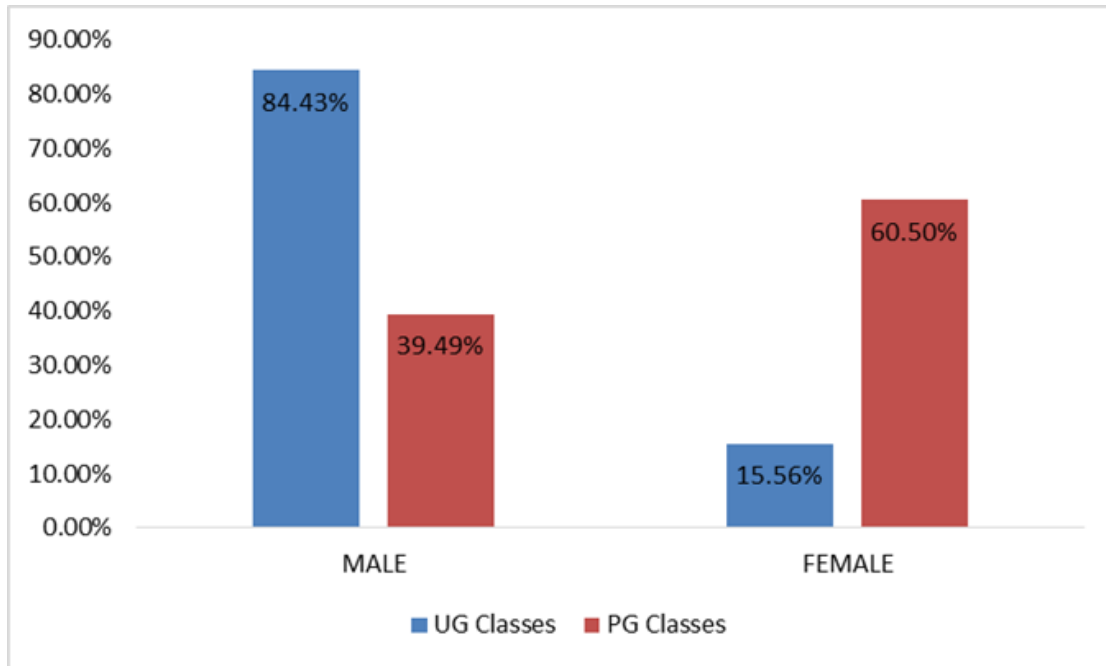


Diagram Showing Gender Diversity of UG and PG Students

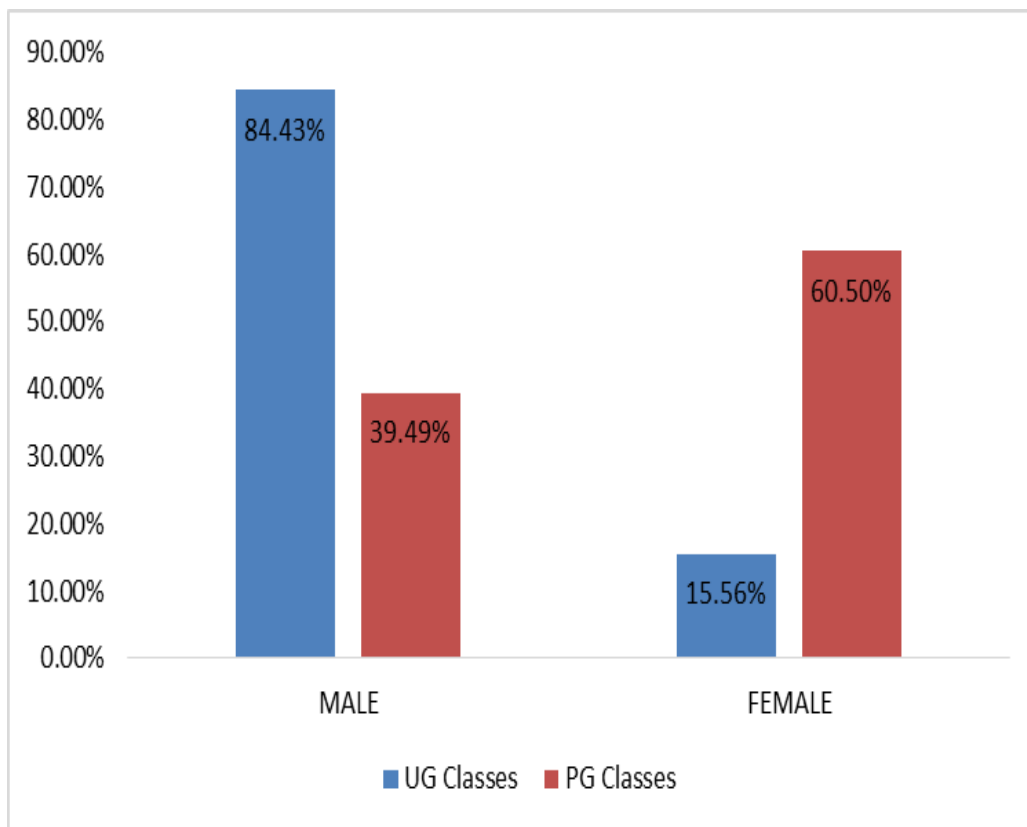


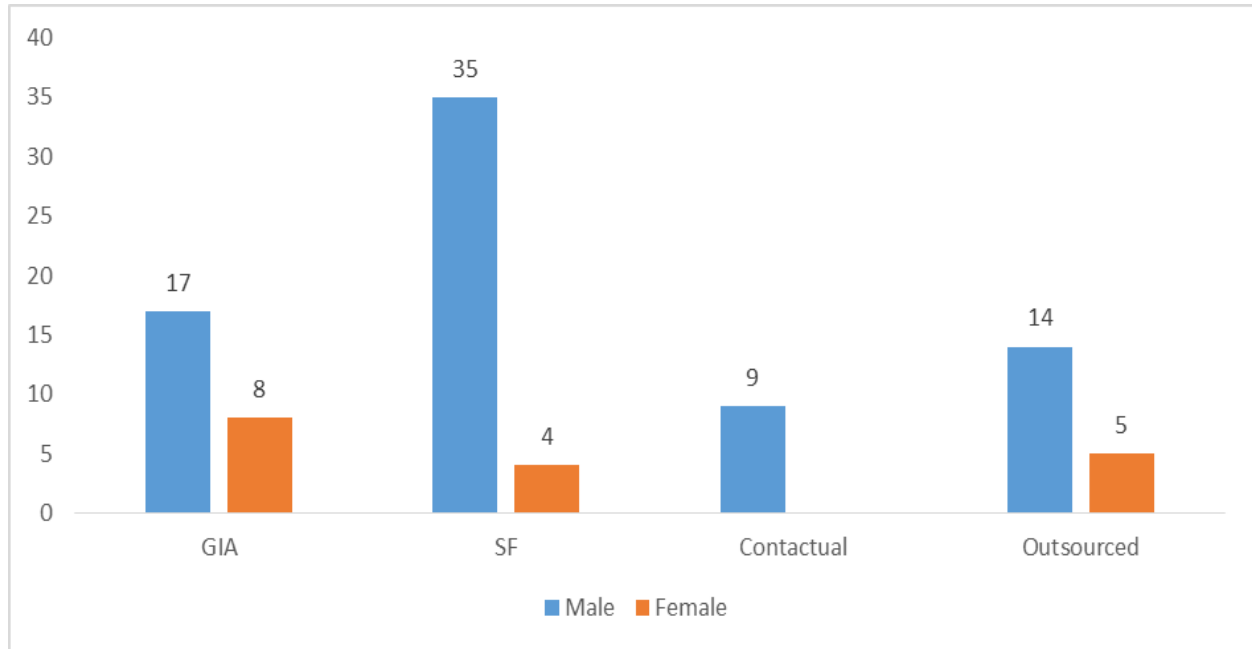
Diagram Showing Gender Diversity of UG and PG Students

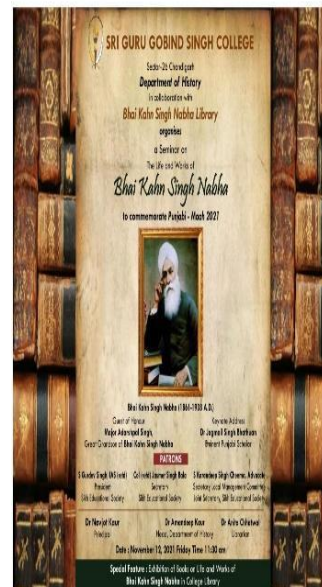
**The Life and Works of Bhai Kahn Singh Nabha to Commemorate Punjabi Maah 2021**
