The College Calendar 2023: Hermeneutics of Sikh Music (Raags) through Art portrays two crucial dimensions of Sikh thought and practice, philosophy and aesthetics through paintings which are a unique blend of the Word (Shabad, Language, Meaning, Interpretation) and its performance in Music and Song (Raag/melody, taal/metric cycle, bhaav/expression, instruments). A humble effort has been made to appreciate our rich heritage and culture preserved through art form with an objective to explore the traditional music of Sikhism by portraying the important Raags according to their aesthetic mood as mentioned in the holy Sri Guru Granth Sahib.

The sacred Word occurs within a specific context, a context that requires knowledge of eternal time, religious history, ethics and morals, psychology, spiritual signs and wonders, mysticism with Almighty as focus. The Music is not performed for its own sake but it is tied to the improvement and transformation of life through the recitation of *Shabad* in prayer, the singing of prayer in prescribed *Raags*, sermons and exegesis.

Sri Guru Granth Sahib, the holy text, is the supreme authority in Sikhism which is considered to be the living Guru after the lineage of ten Gurus starting from the first Guru, Sri Guru Nanak Dev till the tenth Guru, Sri Guru Gobind Singh. The composition of Sri Guru Granth Sahib includes the valuable teachings in the form of mystic hymns of thirty six contributors -- six of Sikh Gurus and thirty saints from different regions and religions and comprises of 1430 pages in total. These religious teachings are classified under different *Raags*. Although there are 31 main *Raags* in Sri Guru Granth Sahib with a total of 60 that include sub-*raags*. Every *Raag* has a separate aesthetic form and mood which can be perceived by the listeners hence adding a profound meaning to it.

In the medieval times going back to the 16th century, Guru Nanak, for 'devotional love' and *Naam Simran* (dwelling on His Name), spread the gospel of *Dhur ki Baani* (revealed Word) in the musical form. Bhai Mardana, follower of Guru Nanak accompanied him on string instrument called *Rabab*. Carrying this legacy forward, all the Sikh Gurus sang in the praise of Almighty and chose music as a medium to

convey the Divine message to the masses. The Masters, no doubt, directed us to sing the hymns (*Gurbani Kirtan*) in the prescribed *raags* mentioned in the Sikh sacred scripture. Besides Guru Nanak's personal association with the *Rabab*, successor Gurus also took keen interest in the development and/or learning of string instruments. Sikh string instruments are important for *Gurbani Kirtan* as they rejuvenate a sense of belonging to our rich past and give a connection back to our roots and history.

When the Divine abides forever in the heart of such, the mind is then always stable and unequalled.


By contemplating over the Word of Guru, one obtains the priceless jewel.



Gauri Raag is auspicious if it induces one to contemplate the Almighty.


Walking in harmony with the Will of Divine should be our adornment.






The melody and music of the *Raags* and the Word of the *Shabad* are beautiful, when you meditate deeply on the Almighty.


