Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the College conducted presentations of AQAR (Annual quality assurance Report) 2020-21 in the Hari Singh Nalwa Multiple Hall from January 31, 2022 to February 04, 2022 in the presence of Chief Coordinator (Principal), Steering team, Proof Reading Committee and SSR Compilation Committee, Conveners, Coconveners and Criterion-wise NAAC Committee members.

Agenda of the meeting: To discuss filled data of AQAR 2020-21 and to encourage self-evaluation and feedback among faculty members.

Presentation of *PART A of AQAR* was made by Coordinator IQAC, Dr Sonia Batta on Jan 31, 2022 who addressed everyone regarding submission of an Annual self-reviewed progress report i.e. Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) to NAAC, through IQAC. The report will detail the tangible results achieved in key areas, specifically identified by the IQAC at the beginning of the Academic year.

Presentation of *Extended profile*was made by Dr Shraddha Arya on Jan 31, 2022 who showcased in detail the extended profile data and the corresponding concerns. Relevant feedback was provided by the faculty regarding some discrepancies.

Presentation of Criterion I i.e. *Curricular Aspects* was made by Mr. Kulbir Singh on February 1, 2022 where all points leading to curriculum enrichment were discussed. Suggestions were invited from faculty regarding improvement in the Criteria.

Presentation of Criterion II, *Teaching, Learning & Evaluation* was made by Ms. Kanwal Dhanoya on Feb 01, 2022 who explained all parameters concerning the criteria. Some of the points requiring further clarity and optimization were discussed at length.

Presentation of Criterion III, Research, Innovations & Extension was made by Dr Pushpinder Kaur on February 2, 2022 wherein all point related to Research Innovation and the creation of a healthy research ecosystem were discussed.

Presentation of Criterion IV, *Infrastructure & Learning Resources* was made by Prof Bhupinder Singh on February 2, 2-022 regarding the provisions of Infrastructure and support facilities in the institution. Procedures and policies for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities - laboratory, library, sports complex, computers, classrooms etc. were discussed at length.

Presentation on Criterion V, Student Support & Progression was made by Dr Harjit Kaur Virk was made on February 3, 2022. Every possible dimension including number of capability enhancement and development schemes such as Soft skill development, Remedialcoaching, Language lab, Bridge courses, Yoga, Meditation, Personal Counseling and Mentoring etc

were discussed. Institutional mechanisms for transparency and other redressal procedures were also highlighted.

Presentation of Criterion VI, Governance, Leadership & Management was made by Ms. Gursheek Kaur on February3, 2022 wherein all aspects including Vision and Mission, participative processes and Faculty empowerment strategies were discussed.

Presentation on Criterion VII, *Institutional Values & Best* Practices was made by Dr Manipal Kaur on February 4, 2022. Institutional Best Practices were discussed and the need for policy creation was highlighted.

The following points were discussed in detail with all members present in the meeting:

- 1. Conveners of respective Criteria presented the filled data of AQAR along with supporting documents as proofs through PowerPoint presentation.
- 2. Main purpose of the meetings was to cross check the data across criteria and to resolve the discrepancies across various criteria.
- 3. Suggestions were given by Steering team members, SSR compilation committee and Proof reading committee.
- 4. Conveners were given instructions to send edited copies of their criteria after incorporating relevant suggestions.
- 5. Further discussions and deliberations regarding optimization of responses.

The presentations intended to develop a system for conscious, consistent and catalytic improvement in the representation of data. The need to channelize its efforts further and measures towards promoting the holistic development of the institution was highlighted.
